National Safeguarding Team (NST) Survey invitation for survivors of abuse

The Church of England NST is developing a survivor engagement framework with victims and survivors which will set out how the Church will work collaboratively with victims and survivors to develop and improve safeguarding and protect all. A key first step of this development is this national survey with victims and survivors.

Any survivor of abuse can access the survey at <https://www.smartsurvey.co.uk/s/3N71QS/> or ask a trusted person to request a Word document from engage.safeguarding@churchofengland without disclosing personal details.

The survey will run for two months until 18 September, and the learning from the survey will inform a publicly accessible report, which will be published online on the Cof E survivor engagement webpage.
