## Update

Over the past few months, we have been putting together, the Parish Profile - a document that helps prospective Rectors discern whether God may be calling them to lead us at St Leonards. Starting with input from the congregation we have been writing this substantial document that describes who we are, where we believe God is leading us and what we are hoping for from our next Rector. At the end of May the PCC were able to meet with Associate Archdeacon Richard Kellett who helped us review the draft. This was helpful in confirming that our profile is covering everything it needs to, is honest and realistic about the challenges, and likely to be attractive to potential applicants. The profile now needs some final improvements before the PCC come together to approve it enabling us to begin the process of advertising. This is scheduled for early July

Please pray for us as a PCC as we make final changes. Please also continue to pray for the whole process, for the person that God is preparing to bring to us and for the work he is doing in us as we wait.
