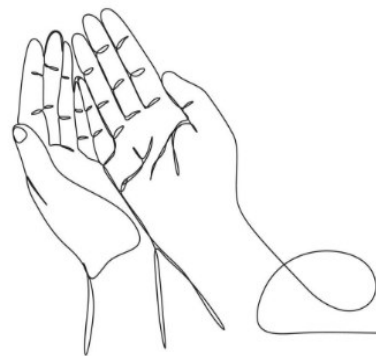
The Dovecote also will be open 2.00 – 4.30 pm on the Sunday.
